Teesside University Courses

Teesside University is currently offering the following fully accredited courses up to level 4 for employers in our region. Each of the courses will be delivered over 6 weeks, Tuesday and Thursdays starting from Tuesday 23rd May 2023 and ending on Thursday 29th June.

The subjects are:

1. Hydrogen Production: Transition Path to Green Hydrogen – suitable for managers, engineers, technicians and researchers
2. Advanced Materials for Hydrogen Applications – suitable for practitioners, process operators, technicians, researchers and managers who are or will be involved in designing hydrogen products, processes or infrastructure.
3. Process Simulation for Hydrogen Production – suitable for practitioners, engineers, technicians, and researchers

Each course costs £750 and is fully accredited to Level 4, 30 credits.

Draft Targeting Operating Model (TOM) Published by Government



The draft TOM sets out a new regime of border import controls, for implementation from October 2023.

The new model will safeguard biosecurity, minimise risks to public health, animal health, the environment and protect the United Kingdom's reputation as a responsible international trading nation.

This new approach will apply equally to goods from the EU and goods from the rest of the world. It will be based on an assessment of risk, with a proportionate and technologically advanced approach to controls, and other transformational projects as part of our 2025 Borders Strategy.
