Help Shape the UK Government Response to US Tariffs



The US has announced that it will impose an additional 10% tariff on top of existing US duties, fees and taxes on imports from the UK. This came into effect on **Saturday 5th April** at **00:01am EST.**

These additional tariffs do not apply to US imports of:

- steel and aluminium articles and automobiles/automobile parts, which are subject to separate additional 25% tariffs.
- copper, pharmaceuticals, semiconductors and lumber.
- energy, energy products and other minerals not available in the US.

The UK Government is consulting businesses across sectors on a potential UK response to the above mentioned tariffs, businesses are invited to share their views and concerns directly with the Department for Business and Trade at the link below.

Businesses have until **11:59pm BST** on **Thursday 1st May** to share your comments with government.

This week the UK government has temporarily suspended the UK Global Tariff on 89 products to make imports cheaper, including certain plastic compounds. More information on the announcement can be found **here**.

New Regulations for Trade Waste



As of 31st March 2025 the law in England has changed and businesses with 10 or more full-time equivalent (FTE) employees are required to recycle a core set of recyclable materials.

By law, businesses are required to manage and dispose of their waste in a responsible manner. The benefits of doing this effectively includes helping in the effort to tackle climate change and enhancing your image and customer retention.

What is the new legislation?

The new legislation in England requires waste and recycling to be separated:

- **Food waste** must be collected separately from other waste.
- **Dry mixed recycling** includes plastic, metal, glass, paper and cardboard.
- Black bin waste residual waste.

Please speak to your contracted waste collection provider, who will advise you on what collections they are able to provide and answer any questions you may have regarding the new legislation.

Procurement Opportunity for Provision of Short Breaks



Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council wish to appoint Providers to the Framework for the provision of short breaks for children and young people with disabilities and their families.

Through this framework services are provided under the following Lots:

Lot 1 – Clubs. Redcar and Cleveland commissioned clubs in local accessible venues identified by providers. Clubs may include but are not limited to after school clubs, weekend clubs and holiday clubs.

Lot 2 – Individual Support Services. Individual Support Services that are personalised to meet an individual's needs and are usually provided as a solo service requiring 1:1 support or higher. Care and/or support can be provided in the family home or in the community.

Lot 3 – Overnight Support Away from Home. Overnight support provided outside of the family home in a registered venue/home.

Lot 4 – Services in the Community. Any community or outreach service that isn't covered in Lot 2 or 3 that could provide a specialist short break.






