





Teesside Karting rebrands as Teesside Motorsports



Teesside Karting recently announced a new chapter in its journey with a full rebrand to Teesside Motorsports.

This evolution reflects the venue's growing role as a hub for diverse motorsport and communityfocused activities. Alongside the rebrand, Teesside Motorsports is launching a brand-new website and a powerful new mental health initiative: Motivate: Race to Talk.

A NEW NAME FOR A BROADER VISION

The change to Teesside Motorsports marks the transformation of the business from a karting circuit into a wider-reaching motorsport and leisure venue. From endurance kart races to track days, community events, and youth development programmes, the new name better represents the scope of what's on offer across the site's 50-acre footprint. "Our roots are in karting, and that will always be a core part of what we do," said Kat Franklin, Managing Director. "But we've grown far beyond that. The rebrand reflects who we are today—an accessible, community-driven motorsports venue that supports fun, competition, mental wellbeing and local opportunity."

The rebrand is accompanied by the launch of www.teessidemotorsports.co.uk, a new website designed to make it easier than ever to explore events, make bookings, and keep up to date with everything happening on site. The modern, mobile-friendly site brings all Teesside's activities under one roof, offering seamless access to racing info, café services, leagues, training programmes, and charity events.

LAUNCHING MOTIVATE: RACE TO TALK

One of the most exciting elements of this new era is the official launch of Motivate: Race to Talk, a charitable initiative created to raise awareness of mental health and reduce stigma across the motorsport community.

Developed in partnership with organisations such as Andy's Man Club and the National Karting Association, Race to Talk provides:

- Mental health signposting and information at all major events
- Regular touchpoint events with karting and café access for open discussion
- Training for staff and volunteers to offer first-line support
- Fundraising and awareness campaigns supporting national and local charities

"Our paddock is filled with young men and women facing all sorts of pressures," said Franklin.

"Motivate: Race to Talk is our commitment to making this a safe space where mental health is treated with the importance it deserves."


