The Land of Iron\* at Skinningrove celebrates the iron and steel history of the borough; the Zetland Lifeboat Museum in Redcar is home to the world's oldest surviving lifeboat and Saltburn-by-the-Sea still operates the oldest water balanced cliff tramway in Britain and retains its Victorian Pier, built from local iron, the first and last remaining pleasure pier on the North East coast.


coastline is one of astonishing contrasts – dramatic sea cliffs, sweeping bays and eight miles of unbroken sands. Stroll along Redcar's Esplanade or venture up the 80ft high Redcar Beacon to enjoy the stunning views of Redcar seafront. Marske-by-the-Sea, is a quieter part of the coast that continues onto the Blue Flag awarded Saltburnby-the-Sea. Cattersty Sands in Skinningrove is a long stretch of golden sandy beach, secluded with rocks and a pier.

This provides the perfect setting for a wide range of outdoor pursuits, from traditional bucket-andspade fun to surfing. You can also experience the thrills of boogie boarding, surf skiing or windsurfing; sailing or fishing.











Full of inspirational creativity Redcar and Cleveland is home to some fantastic public art, exhibitions and theatres.

Explore nature and all its wonders at Kirkleatham Walled Garden. The Grade II listed Walled Garden has been restored back to its former glory and features formal gardens, a science garden, a glass house, exhibition space, a café and a produce shop.

The Steel Stories exhibition at Kirkleatham Museum showcases real-life stories, artefacts and photos from local steel workers whose past labour shapes our industrial culture today.

Imaginations are captured by displays of artwork by local artists and outdoor public art all help play a role in the cultural evolution of the borough.

Redcar and Cleveland gives you the opportunity to either hike for miles or stroll for an hour through unspoilt landscapes and beside scenic beaches. Guisborough is the gateway to the North York Moors National Park, giving access to footpaths and bridleways stretching across moorland to picturesque villages like Skelton, Loftus and Skinningrove.
